






We were also able to host 3 leisure events to help introduce our clients to others who may be in similar situations.

Babysitting Course


The babysitting course is designed for individuals aged 12 to 16, aiming to prepare them for responsible childcare. The program includes 8 hours of intensive training, covering essential subjects like child safety, basic first aid, ageappropriate activities, and effective responses to common childcare situations. After successfully completing the course, participants will have the skills and knowledge needed to care for children between 3 months and 11 years. To evaluate their comprehension, a final test is conducted with a pass rate of 75%. Upon successful completion, participants will receive a wallet certificate and a wall certificate, acknowledging their commitment to becoming capable and self-assured babysitters. Moreover, the manual book is provided to participants upon registration.
